



Our Stories GROW YOUR HISTORY

JULY 01, 1899

Thomas Andrew Dorsey

Born in Villa Rica, GA. Thomas Dorsey is known widely as the "Father of Gospel Music," was a pianist, composer, arranger, singer, and lyricist. Thomas Dorsey, who coined the phrase "gospel" and composed over 1,000 gospel works and 2,000 blues songs, died in Chicago, Illinois, on January 23, 1993.

JULY 01, 1919

East St. Louis Race War

This act of white domestic terrorism aimed at Black residents and business owners is estimated to have tortured and killed 200 (though probably more) Black people. Martial law was declared. A congressional investigating committee said, "It is not possible to give accurately the number of dead." 'The bodies of the dead Negroes,' testified an eye witness,'were thrown into a morgue like so many dead hogs.' There were 312 buildings and 44 railroad freight cars and their contents destroyed by fire."

JULY 02, 1822

Telemaque "Denmark" Vessey

Born in St. Thomas, 1767, Denmark Vessey gained his freedom in Charleston, South Carolina. Warning that God helps those who help themselves, Vessy laid the plans for a massive slave revolt and enlisted the aid of over 9,000 enslaved people. Using information cells which only allowed certain amounts of information to limited amounts of people, Vessey organized a complete plot. Given its goals, the revolt would have been impressive had the conspirators not been given away by a fellow slave. Under arrest, in the face of continued threats, promises, and torture. Only one of the condemned men ever gave away information. One of the leaders, a slave known as Peter Poyas, told his men, "Do not open your lips. Dis silent as you shall see me do." Vessey and his co-conspirators were hanged on July 2, 1822, the freedom they sought finally at hand.

JULY 04, 1881

Tuskegee University

Formerly known as the Tuskegee Institute, is a

private, historically black land-grant university in Tuskegee, Alabama as the Tuskegee Normal School for Colored Teachers. Hired as principal of the new normal school (for the training of teachers) in Tuskegee, Alabama, Booker T. Washington opened his school on July 4, 1881, on the grounds of the Butler Chapel African Methodist Episcopal Zion Church. The following year, he bought the grounds of a former plantation, out of which he expanded

Dr. Daniel Hale Williams performs the worlds first open-heart surgery on a young man named James Cornish.

JULY 12, 1949

Air-Condtioning

Frederick McKinley Jones patents the air conditioning unit.

JULY 21, 1818

Charles Lewis Reason

Born on July 21, 1818 in New York City. His parents, Michiel and Elizabeth Reason, immigrated from Haiti (Ayaiti) arriving shortly after the Haitian (Ayaitian) Revolution of 1793. The young Reason displayed an aptitude for mathematics when he was a student at the New York African Fee School. Reason began his teaching career when he was 14 years old. saving what he could of his teacher's \$25 per year salary to continue his own education with tutors. A political activist and abolitionist, Reason played a prominent role in the Negro Convention Movement in New York. In 1837 Reason joined Henry Highland Garnet, among others, in an effort to gain voting rights for African American men and he was later one of the co-authors of the call for the New York Convention of 1840.
